## SPECIALTY AREA REQUIREMENTS

A student pursuing this major will consult with a designated advisor to design a major program of study that meets the requirements listed below.

The specialty area must meet the following criteria:

- The major must include a minimum of **36 hours**.
- The student must select courses from four separate disciplines chosen from the list below.
- A minimum of nine credit hours must be taken from each of the four selected disciplines.
- At least 18 hours of the major must be in upper division (300 and 400 level) courses.
- The student must achieve a minimum major GPA of 2.0.
- A minimum of 120 hours are required for graduation. If the major is only 36 hours, the student must take enough general electives to fill the remaining hours required for graduation.
- Courses designated as general education or religion core requirements will not count toward the major, even if the student did not take the course(s) to meet general core or religion requirements.
